



**NOTICE - Health Care Provider Travel into Maryland
(April 24, 2020)**

A healthcare provider licensed in Maryland or another jurisdiction engaged in activities authorized under such license at a Maryland health care facility pursuant to the Executive Order Relating to Various Health Care Matters of March 16, 2020 who travels into Maryland from anywhere outside Maryland is not required to self-quarantine for 14 days unless the provider otherwise meets the CDC criteria for self-quarantine.

All healthcare providers are required to adhere to all relevant U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Maryland Department of Health guidance for risk assessment and potential exposure in a healthcare setting to Patients with COVID-19 and to take appropriate action should COVID-19 symptoms develop.

This Notice is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until the state of emergency has been terminated and the proclamation of the catastrophic health emergency has been rescinded.
