## Maryland Primary Care Program (MDPCP) Practice Checklist

### About the Program

Governor Larry Hogan, together with the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), announced the federal approval of Maryland’s Total Cost of Care All-Payer Model, known as the “Maryland Model”. A central part of the Maryland Model is the Maryland Primary Care Program (MDPCP), which supports the delivery of advanced primary care throughout the State and allows community providers to play an increasingly important role in improving health outcomes and controlling total health care spending growth.
