DDA TCM Temporary Emergency Rate Increase

DDA Targeted Case Management: For dates of service beginning October 1, 2022, the Maryland Medical Assistance reimbursement rate for Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) targeted case management (TCM) providers will receive a one-time temporary emergency rate increase of 10 percent using 100 percent American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. This temporary rate increase will expire on December 31, 2022. These TCM services are also called Coordination of Community Services. DDA TCM services target three populations of individuals with developmental disabilities; (1) individuals on the Developmental Disabilities Waiting List who have been determined to have a disability; (2) individuals needing community coordination services; and (3) individuals transitioning to the community. The general rate will be \$27.02 per unit for general and the geographic differential rate will be \$28.45 for geographic differential rate per unit. This represents an estimated \$2,353,684 total fund increase using 100% ARPA savings. On January 1, 2023, the TCM rates will revert back to the rates approved on July 1, 2022; the rate will be \$24.56 for general and \$25.86 for geographic differential rate per unit.
