

Referring Medicaid HealthChoice Patients to a Covered Diabetes Prevention Program

Refer eligible Medicaid HealthChoice patients to the National Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP), an evidence-based year-long lifestyle change program designed to prevent or delay the onset of type 2 diabetes.

Providers can refer a patient by contacting the patient's HealthChoice managed care organization (MCO) or through the CRISP referral tool. The MCO will help the patient enroll.

Encourage your patients to participate in the program. Note that pregnant patients are an exclusion for DPP program participation.
