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Report on Nursing Home Medicaid Participation and Revenue

Nursing Facility Reimbursement, by County, and Ownership Type, Fiscal Year 2024

In fiscal year (FY) 2024, there were 206 NFs enrolled and actively participating in the Maryland Medicaid program. Collectively, the facilities received \$1,734,392,859 in total Medicaid reimbursements during this period as recorded in the NF cost report data provided by Maryland’s fiscal audit contractor, Myers and Stauffer, LC^{1,2}. Table 1 lists the Medicaid reimbursement totals by local jurisdiction and NF ownership type for FY 2024.

Baltimore City, Baltimore County, and Montgomery County had the highest concentration of facilities within their jurisdictions, leading to the highest total Medicaid reimbursements. Queen Anne’s County, Caroline County, and Talbot County were among the counties with the lowest number of facilities, resulting in the lowest Medicaid reimbursements.

There was one (1) facility in Sussex County, Delaware that participated as a Maryland Medicaid provider, and this facility received a total Medicaid reimbursement of \$1,064,186 in FY 2024.

FY 2024 Medicaid Reimbursement by Ownership Type

Table 2 lists the FY 2024 Medicaid reimbursement totals by ownership type for the 206 NFs participating in the Maryland Medicaid program. For-profit NFs received the highest percentage of the total Medicaid reimbursements followed by not-for-profit facilities and government facilities.
