23-0001 PACE	Att. 3.1A pg. 19C & Supp 3 to Att. 3.1A pg. 11E,F	modifies its methodology by which is gathers data to calculate rates for PACE in order to identify possible regions for future expansion. PACE will be grouped into three regions (Baltimore Metro, Washington Metro, and Rural), rather than pulling data only from Baltimore City.
