Overview

- HB1080: Healthy Babies Equity Act (Acts of 2022)
 - Comprehensive care for non-citizen pregnant individuals and their children
 - Eligible for Medicaid but for immigration status
 - Four months postpartum coverage
 - Retroactive coverage
 - One year of coverage for the child
 - Up to 250% FPL
- Anticipated 6,000 pregnant individuals will be eligible for enrollment
- Coverage goes live July 1, 2023



Benefits Package

- Same benefits as other pregnant participants
- Comprehensive care
 - Medical care
 - Behavioral health services
 - Dental services
 - Prescription drugs
 - No copays



Retroactive Coverage

- Up to the 3 months immediately preceding the month of application
 - Individual must have been pregnant or in the postpartum period during those months to qualify for retro
- Applicants may apply for coverage during their postpartum period
- For example, if an individual applies for and qualifies for coverage on July 1, 2023, they would be eligible for retroactive coverage back to April 1, 2023, so long as they were pregnant or within 4 months postpartum as of April 1.






Potentially eligible pregnant individuals can apply through Maryland Health Connection Consumer Portal
