## ASSISTANCE IN COMMUNITY INTEGRATION SERVICES (ACIS) PROGRAM RATES

## PAYMENT RATES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2025

The Assistance in Community Integration Services (ACIS) Program provides housing and tenancy-based case management services to qualified Medical Assistance participants.

ACIS Providers are reimbursed at a bundled rate for delivering at least three eligible services per participant per calendar month. It is encouraged to deliver at least one service in-person; however, services can be delivered via telehealth at the request of the participant. Qualifying services will be reimbursed per member per month (PMPM) as a Fee for Service (FFS) benefit. ACIS providers are not to bill MCOs for these services.

Additionally, ACIS Providers are reimbursed for qualified compliance activities which includes completion of Housing Supports Care Plan per participant as well as complying with Maryland Medicaid's Section 1115 HealthChoice Demonstration ACIS Special Terms and Conditions requirements. These activities will be reimbursed per member per 365 days as a FFS benefit.

## **BILLING CODES**

ACIS Providers must bill the Medical Assistance Program using the billing codes identified in Table 1 below.

ACIS Providers must utilize a diagnosis code (ICD-10 Z-code) related to homelessness when submitting a claim for reimbursement of ACIS program services. The diagnosis code describes the participant's condition and the reason for services. Required diagnosis code options related to homelessness are outlined in Table 2.
