



Public Notice for Maryland Medicaid DMS/DME and Oxygen Rate Adjustment — Revised Effective Date

Maryland Medicaid published public notice on July 1, 2020 regarding a rate adjustment for Disposable Medical Supplies and Durable Medical Equipment (DMS/DME) and Oxygen reimbursement rates effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2020. Maryland Medicaid is updating the effective date for this change.

Effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2021, Maryland Medicaid reimbursement rates for DMS/DME and Oxygen will decrease from 85 percent of the Medicare rate to 80 percent of the current Medicare rate for DMS/DME and Oxygen services on the Medicare fee schedule. This reduction will not impact codes on the Medicare fee schedule for parenteral and enteral supplies or hardware (i.e., B codes). This represents an estimated \$737,255 decrease in total funds (44.1 percent general funds \$325,232; 55.9 percent federal funds \$412,023).
