Subject: Clarification of DME Transmittal no. 67 (2013 Rate reduction)

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This memo clarifies Maryland Medicaid transmittal no. 67, addressing the July 1, 2013 rate reduction of Durable Medical Equipment, Disposable Supplies and Oxygen services.

Recently, the Durable Medical Equipment, Disposable Supplies and Oxygen Unit (DME/DMS/OXY) issued a transmittal announcing the reduction of the reimbursement rate of DME/DMS/OXY services from 90 percent to 85 percent of Medicare's rate. Effective July 1, 2013, Medicare began phase one of Competitive Bidding. Since Maryland Medicaid is not currently participating in competitive bidding, the reduction will be taken from Medicare's April 2013 fee schedule when billing for non-dual eligible fee-for-service recipients.
