Re:

Change in Reimbursement to District of Columbia Hospitals

Effective July 1, 2011

In order to comply with the FY 2012 budget passed by the Maryland General Assembly, the HealthChoice managed care organizations (MCOs) are required to pay all DC hospitals the rate of reimbursement paid by the Maryland Medicaid fee-for-service program for all dates of service on or after July 1, 2011. The only exception to this methodology will be if an MCO executes a contract for a mutually agreed upon alternative rate arrangement on or after July 1, 2011.

Under the fee for service rate methodology, DC hospitals are paid on a percent of charges basis. There is a separate rate for inpatient and outpatient services for each of the facilities, based on cost data submitted annually by each hospital and adjusted for any budget initiatives.
