



Substance Use Disorders (SUD) Medications

These medications are carved out of the MCO pharmacy benefit and are payable as fee-for-service through Maryland Medical Assistance. Some of these drugs are subject to the prior authorization requirements of the Preferred Drug List (PDL), clinical criteria, and quantity limits.
