Subject: Discontinuation of Telehealth for Certain Services

Note: Please ensure the appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.

On December 22, 2021, via <u>Provider Transmittal 27-22</u>, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH), Medicaid Office of Long Term Services and Supports, authorized the continuation of reimbursement to providers for services determined to be clinically appropriate for delivery via telehealth.

As discussed at the December 2022 Model Waiver Advisory Board Meeting, effective July 1, 2023, the following services, which were previously authorized to be completed via telehealth, may no longer be provided in this manner and the MDH will not reimburse providers for these services delivered via telehealth:

- Registered Nurse Supervisory Visits (Staff training and supervision)
- Initial and significant change assessments (Private duty nursing)

As previously discussed, effective July 1, 2023, the following services may continue to be provided via telehealth, MDH will reimburse providers for services delivered via telehealth below:

• Model Waiver Case Management (when authorized by the Division of Nursing Services (DONS))
