- Re: Maryland Medicaid Reimbursement for Services Provided by Pharmacists within Their Lawful Scope of Practice, Effective January 1, 2024

Note: Please ensure that the appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.

Effective January 1, 2024, Senate Bill 678/House Bill 1151 (Ch. 300 of the Acts of 2023) allows Medicaid enrolled pharmacists to bill Maryland Medicaid for services within their lawful scope of practice. This requirement applies to Medicaid fee-for-service (FFS) and Health Choice managed care organizations (MCOs). Pharmacists who meet all Medicaid and Board of Pharmacy (Board) requirements as described in COMAR 10.09.21 and the requirements of Health Occupations Article 12 of the Pharmacy Act may bill for the following new services:

- Smoking Cessation Counseling
- Medication Therapy Management (MTM)

The following codes are now billable by pharmacists who follow the enrollment and billing guidelines described below:

99211	Office or other outpatient visit for the evaluation and management of an established patient that may not require the presence of a physician or other qualified healthcare professional (for contraceptive purposes only).	\$25.44	Jan. 1, 2019

99407	Smoking cessation counseling visit greater than 10 minutes	\$30.60	Jan. 1, 2024

99607	MTM additional 8-15 mins.	\$24.54	Jan.1, 2024

* To bill for this code, pharmacies must be enrolled in the <u>VFC Program</u>.

Provider Eligibility

To bill for services, an actively licensed pharmacist must meet the eligibility criteria outlined in COMAR 10.09.21. Pharmacists can enroll via ePREP at <u>eprep.health.maryland.gov</u>. When enrolling, please select provider type PH - Pharmacist Prescriber (or Pharmacist). Pharmacies must submit a group Pharmacist application, along with applications for individual rendering pharmacists. The pharmacist group will serve as the billing provider for claims related to the above services. MCOs are responsible for educating providers and Health Choice participants about covered pharmacy services and their organization's policies for reimbursement.

Additional information regarding clinical coverage criteria will be published in a future transmittal prior to implementation.

Billing for Services

Medicaid enrolled FFS pharmacist groups may bill Maryland Medicaid using the billing and coding information listed above. General guidance on the CMS-1500 Paper Billing Instructions can be accessed at: <u>https://health.maryland.gov/mmcp/provider/Pages/ffsclaims.aspx</u>.
