Subject: MOM Case Management Services Code for Submitting Managed Care

Encounters, Effective January 1, 2024

Note: Please ensure the appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.

Effective January 1, 2024, HealthChoice managed care organizations (MCOs) will submit encounters for the Maryland Department of Health's (MOM) program using **MC050** for MOM Case Management Services.

The code will be utilized on a per member, per month (PMPM) basis for individuals actively enrolled in MOM case management services. Starting January 1, 2024, rates will be \$208 PMPM for all MOM member month types (intake, ongoing and substantive outreach) per the guidance in the MOM case management manual.

This code will supplement the current method of manually reporting MOM member months. MCOs are still required to submit monthly Care Delivery Partner and Outreach Attempt Log reports.

Guidance:

 MCOs will use their 9-digit Medicaid provider identification number with a '5' added to the beginning as the NPI for both billing provider and rendering provider (e.g., 5XXXXXXXX).

- MCOs may submit one encounter per month per actively enrolled MOM participant.
 MCOs may be required to void any additional encounters processed for a participant in a month.
- No specific diagnosis code will be required for the encounter. MCOs should apply pregnancy- or OUD-related diagnosis codes. Examples may include:
 - o F11.20: Opioid Dependence, Uncomplicated
 - o F11.10: Opioid Abuse, Uncomplicated
 - o O26.90: Pregnancy Related Conditions, Unspecified, Unspecified Trimester
 - Z34.80: Encounter for Supervision of Other Normal Pregnancy, Unspecified Trimester
- MCOs should submit the encounter to MDH with a paid amount of \$208 using the existing process for priced encounters. MOM case management services are built into capitation on a risk corridor basis.
