To enroll as an Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) - Addiction provider, you must be licensed by The Behavioral Health Administration to provide at least one of the following levels of care:

- 3.5
- 3.7
- 3.7 WM

If you have not yet been issued a license by the Behavioral Health Administration (BHA), be sure to upload one of the following documents to ePREP:

1) Approval letter from the Behavioral Health Administration (BHA)that lists at least one of the required levels of care

## Only an option for revalidations:

2) Continuation letter from the Behavioral Health Administration (BHA) <u>AND</u> a copy of the expired approval letter or license under 10.47 that lists at least one of the required levels of care

After you receive your Medical Assistance enrollment approval, your Carelon ID number will be emailed, faxed, or mailed to your address of record.

Once you receive your ID, please register with Carelon Behavioral Health of Maryland for authorization.
