



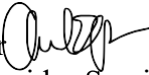

RE: Behavioral Technician Credential Upgrade - ePREP Process Prior to the MPRIME Hold

NOTE: **Please ensure that appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.**

This transmittal updates providers on the application process for Behavioral Technicians (BT) upgrading their credentials to Registered Behavior Technicians (RBT) prior to the August 1, 2026 MPRIME application hold.

BTs upgrading their credentials to RBTs between now and the August 1, 2026 MPRIME application hold, as described in [PT 59-26 Provider Enrollment Portal Transition](#), must follow the process below.

All BTs upgrading their credentials to RBT must submit a new enrollment application under the new provider type RB and should not update their credentials under their existing BT provider type. The new application must include a copy of their RBT Certification. Upon approval, Maryland Medicaid will issue a new Provider Medicaid ID, and the current BT level Provider Medicaid ID will be terminated at the time the new RBT account is created.

Providers who do not submit their updated credentials by July 31st will be unable to do so until MPRIME becomes available in October 2026.
