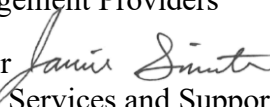

RE: Fiscal Year 2027 Rates for the Developmental Disabilities Administration
Targeted Case Management Services

NOTE: **Please ensure that appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.**

This transmittal updates providers on the rates for Targeted Case Management (TCM) services provided under certain Medicaid programs operated by the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA).

Effective July 1, 2026, the Maryland Medical Assistance Program will decrease rates by two (2) percent based on FY 2027 budget allocations. TCM services include Comprehensive Assessments, Community Coordination, Waiting List Coordination for individuals not enrolled in a waiver, and Transition Coordination for individuals residing in an institution for up to six months prior to transition.

Effective July 1, 2026, the rate for the Comprehensive Assessment will be \$441.00 per assessment, and the rate for TCM Community Coordination, Waiting List Coordination, and Transition Coordination will be \$27.76 per 15-minute unit to reflect this rate adjustment. In addition, effective July 1, 2026, a geographic differential rate of \$29.76 per 15-minute unit for Coordination services only will apply to services provided to participants residing in designated Maryland counties with a higher cost of living. These counties include:

- (1) Calvert County;
- (2) Charles County;
- (3) Frederick County;
- (4) Montgomery County; and
- (5) Prince George's County.
