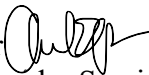

RE: Updated MPRIME Resources

This transmittal updates providers that the Maryland Department of Health is updating its provider enrollment website resources in preparation for the implementation of the Maryland Provider Registration and Information Management Enterprise (MPRIME), which is scheduled to go live in October 2026.

Effective immediately, the previous ePREP enrollment website and resource links have been replaced with new URLs. Providers should begin using the new webpages for all provider enrollment information, guidance, and MPRIME-related resources.

The new webpages will serve as Maryland Medicaid's primary source for provider enrollment information throughout the MPRIME transition and beyond. Providers are encouraged to bookmark these pages, as they will be updated regularly with important announcements, implementation guidance, training materials, user guides, frequently asked questions, and other resources to support the transition from ePREP to MPRIME.

As part of Maryland Medicaid's provider readiness efforts, the MPRIME Resources page will include information on upcoming training opportunities, recorded webinars, workflow documents, quick reference guides, and other implementation tools designed to assist providers in preparing for the October 2026 system launch.

Maryland Medicaid appreciates your partnership and cooperation as we modernize the provider enrollment experience. We encourage providers to visit these webpages regularly to stay informed of important updates leading up to the MPRIME implementation.

ePREP RTP Requests

Effective July 16, 2026, all applications will be denied after they have been returned to the provider three times. Failure to make the corrections outlined in the return-to-provider notice will result in the denial of the current application.

If an application is denied, providers will need to resubmit it in the MPRIME system this October. All providers who submit new applications in MPRIME are eligible for their effective date to be backdated to the corresponding application hold date. For Moderate and High-risk providers, this date is July 1, 2026. For Low-risk providers, this date is August 1, 2026.
