Re: Adjustment to Fiscal Year 2009 Program Rates

On July 1, 2008, payment rates increased for certain services under the Waiver for Older Adults Program. Rates increased by 1.5 percent based on the Medical Assistance Program's budget for Fiscal Year 2009. Due to a budget allocation adjustment, the total rate increase will be 2.0 percent effective November 1, 2008 for services provided under the Waiver for Older Adults.

Attached is a list of revised payment rates for Fiscal Year 2009. **Providers may bill the new rates for services provided on or after November 1, 2008.**
