This transmittal updates providers on the telehealth requirements for Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) services.

**ABA Telehealth Service Delivery Requirements**

Effective April 1, 2026, the services listed in the table below may no longer be rendered 100% via telehealth. At least 25% of the service must be rendered in-person, and 75% can be rendered via telehealth.

Procedure Code	Description
97155	Supervision of a RBT/BCaBA/BT
97156/97156-U2	Parent Training
97157	Group Parent Training

This guidance supersedes the telehealth guidelines found in [PT 11-22 Guidance on the Continuation of Telehealth for ABA Services](#).

When billing for telehealth services that utilize two-way HIPAA compliant audio-visual equipment, providers must bill using the GT modifier to indicate telehealth delivery model.
