Re: Using Simplified Resident Forms

A simplified Resident Assessment Tool (RAT) was piloted in 2012 with a small group of providers. Their feedback was incorporated into a new assessment tool, which has been in effect since 2013.

*When the revised RAT is completed by the DN, it will meet the requirements for the RAT and the DN's assessment. If the RAT is completed by someone other than the DN, the DN is still required to document

their own assessment.

A few facts about the revised form:

- 1. It is optional. You may continue to use the 3-part RAT instead.
- 2. If you require a Level of Care score for Medicaid Waiver, you must continue using the 3-part RAT.
- 3. If you use the revised RAT, you must also use the corresponding revised Service Plan. There are no exceptions to this. (However, it is acceptable to use the revised Service Plan with the 3-part RAT.)
- 4. Deficiencies may result if the forms are not completed in their entirety.
