FOR MARYLAND STATE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ONLY

Department of the Treasury Complete Form W-4 so that your employer can withhold the correct federal income tax from your pay.

(c) If there are only two jobs total, you may check this box. Do the same on Form W-4 for the other job. This option is accurate for jobs with similar pay; otherwise, more tax than necessary may be withheld
