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for at least ONE (1) YEAR; and be it further,

ORDERED that during the probationary period, Ms. Adekoya:

- (1) Shall not practice as a floater pharmacist;
 - (2) Shall not practice as a night shift pharmacist; and
 - (3) Shall ensure that her pharmacist supervisor submits to the Board quarterly reports, utilizing the Board's form, regarding her professional performance;
- and be it further,

ORDERED that after one (1) year of probation, Ms. Adekoya may petition to terminate probation provided that she has fully complied with the probationary terms and has no pending complaints against her; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Adekoya shall at all times cooperate with the Board in the monitoring, supervision, and investigation of her compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Adekoya's failure to fully cooperate with the Board shall be deemed a violation of the terms of probation and a violation of this Order; and be it further,

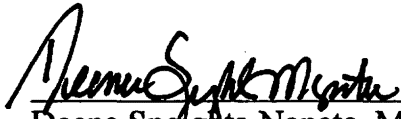
ORDERED that in the event the Board finds for any good faith reason that Ms. Adekoya has violated any of the conditions of probation herein, or in the event that the Board finds for any good faith reason that Ms. Adekoya has committed a violation of Title 12 of the Health Occupations Article or regulations adopted thereunder, the Board may take further disciplinary action against Ms. Adekoya's license provided that she is given notice and an opportunity for a hearing, or issue a summary suspension if

appropriate; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Adekoya shall bear the expenses associated with this Order;
and be it further,

ORDERED that this document constitutes a formal order of the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy and is therefore a public document for purposes of public disclosure, pursuant to the Public Information Act, General Provisions Art. § 4-333, and shall be posted and reported in accordance with State and federal laws.
