## **ORDER OF MODIFICATION**

On or about February 1, 2020, the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") received a request from Katrice Rene (Thompson) Brown, Registration No. T10883, to modify the terms of her Consent Order with the Board, dated December 19, 2018. The Consent Order requires that, during her three-year probationary period, Ms. Brown shall submit to a CJIS criminal background check on renewal of her registration, shall ensure her pharmacy employer submits quarterly performance reports to the Board, and may not have access to controlled dangerous substances ("CDS"). Ms. Brown has been fully compliant with the Consent Order to date. Upon consideration of Ms. Brown's request, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

## **ORDER**

It is this <u>844</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2020, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

**ORDERED** that during the remainder of the three (3) year probationary period, Ms. Brown may have access to CDS in her role as a pharmacy technician; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that all of the other terms of the December 19, 2020 Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions § 4-333(b).
