**Background**

College Pharmacy, Inc (hereinafter referred to as either "College Pharmacy" or the "Applicant") has applied to the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") for a non-resident pharmacy permit to operate a pharmacy providing pharmaceutical services to Maryland residents. College Pharmacy is located in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and has a permit to operate a pharmacy in Colorado under Permit No 240000038.

Upon receiving the application for College Pharmacy, the Board obtained information indicating that Tom Bader, R Ph, President and Manager of College Pharmacy, received two (2) letters of admonition issued by the Colorado Board of Pharmacy regarding illegal manufacturing of prescription drugs. In addition, College Pharmacy was disciplined by the Colorado Board of Pharmacy on December 21, 2005, for compounding and dispensing certain prescription drugs for office use, and for certain recordkeeping violations. The Stipulation and Final Agency Order issued by the Colorado Board requires, among other things, that College Pharmacy submit quarterly reports on its casual sales.

The Board is entering into this Consent Order to condition the issuance of a non-resident pharmacy permit to College Pharmacy on its compliance with the December 21, 2005, Stipulation and Final Agency Order issued by the Colorado Board of Pharmacy

**ORDER**

Based upon an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board under the authority of Health Occupations Article § 12-405, it this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2006, hereby,

ORDERED that the non-resident pharmacy permit application filed by College Pharmacy, Inc , shall be GRANTED upon the following condition

1 College Pharmacy, Inc , shall contemporaneously submit to the Maryland Board of Pharmacy copies of the quarterly reports on casual sales that are reported to the Colorado Board of Pharmacy in accordance with the Stipulation and Final Agency Order, dated December 21, 2005, and

2 College Pharmacy, Inc , shall comply with the Colorado Board of Pharmacy's Stipulation and Final Agency Order, dated December 21, 2005, in all other respects, and be it further,

ORDERED that in the event that the Applicant violates any of the conditions or terms above, the Board, after notice and an opportunity for a hearing, and a determination of a violation, may impose any disciplinary sanction it deems appropriate, including suspension, revocation, and fines, said violation being proven by a preponderance of the evidence, and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order and as such is a public document pursuant to Md Code Ann , State Gov't § 10-611 *et seq* (2004)

4 I acknowledge the legal authority and the jurisdiction of the Board to enter and enforce this Consent Order

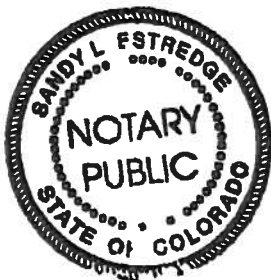
5 I sign this Consent Order freely and voluntarily, after having had the opportunity to consult with counsel I fully understand the language, meaning, and effect of this Consent Order
