## ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION

On September 27, 2019, the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") issued an Order of Suspension of Registration for Delinquent Child Support ("Order of Suspension") against Sherne L. Jones, Pharmacy Technician, Registration No. T21282 (the "Respondent"). The Board suspended the Respondent's registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland due to her delinquent child support payments upon a request from the Baltimore City Office of the Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the "Administration"), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(e)(2)(i).

On or about February 18, 2020, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent's registration from the Administration. However, the Respondent's registration expired on February 29, 2020; as such, the Board cannot reinstate her registration unless the Respondent complies with the requirements for reinstatement provided in COMAR 10.34.34.10.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(k), on this \_5\*\*

**ORDERED** that the suspension of the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland held by Sherne L. Jones, Registration No. T21282, is **LIFTED**; and it is further,

**ORDERED** that upon receipt of a reinstatement application, the Board will reinstate the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland held by Sherne L. Jones, Registration No. T21282, provided she is otherwise eligible for reinstatement as set forth in COMAR 10.34.34.10; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions §4-333(b).
