ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION

On February 2, 2016, the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”) issued an Order of Suspension of Registration for Delinquent Child Support (“Order of Suspension”) against Vincent Knight, Pharmacy Technician, Registration No. T16928 (the “Respondent”). The Board suspended the Respondent’s registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland due to his delinquent child support payments upon a request from the Baltimore City Office of the Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the “Administration”), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(e)(2)(i) (2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about September 18, 2017, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent’s registration from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Pharmacy Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 12-101 *et seq.*, the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a registration. However, the Respondent’s registration expired on February 28, 2017; as such, the Board cannot reinstate his registration unless the Respondent complies with the requirements for reinstatement provided for in COMAR 10.34.34.10.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(k), on this 20
 day of November, 2017, by the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland held by Vincent Knight, Registration No. T16928, is **LIFTED**; and it is further,

ORDERED that upon receipt of a reinstatement application, the Board will reinstate the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland held by Vincent Knight, Registration No. T16928, provided he is otherwise eligible for reinstatement as set forth in COMAR 10.34.34.10; and it is further,

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions §4-333(b).
