SECOND ORDER OF MODIFICATION

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") is in receipt of a petition, dated June 16, 2014, from Chukwuemeka Steve Frank Obidike, License No. 16011, requesting modification of certain terms of probation as set forth in the Board's Order Lifting Suspension, dated September 21, 2011. The Order Lifting Suspension placed Mr. Obidike's license on probation for a period of five (5) years based on prior convictions for obtaining controlled substances by fraud. The Board subsequently issued an Order of Modification on January 29, 2013, allowing Mr. Obidike to work night shifts under certain circumstances. Upon consideration of Mr. Obidike's current petition, the Board voted to further modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

ORDER

It is this 18th day of July, 2014, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

ORDERED that Order Lifting Suspension, dated September 21, 2011, be modified to allow Mr. Obidike to work for a staffing agency; and be it further,

ORDERED that all other terms of the September 21, 2011, Order Lifting Suspension and the Order of Modification, dated January 29, 2013, remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
