CONSENT ORDER FOR INITIAL REGISTRATION

BACKGROUND

On or about May 8, 2015, Sheritia Queen applied to the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") for registration as a pharmacy technician. In accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-02(c), Ms. Queen submitted to a Maryland Criminal Justice Information System ("CJIS") background check. The CJIS report revealed Ms. Queen has a criminal history.

In lieu of instituting formal proceedings against Ms. Queen's application, in accordance with the Maryland Pharmacy Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-01 *et seq.*, the Board has offered Ms. Queen the opportunity to resolve this matter by agreeing to the terms set forth in this Consent Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about May 8, 2015, Ms. Queen applied to the Board for registration as a pharmacy technician.
2. On her application, Ms. Queen answered "no" to the questions "Have you committed a criminal act for which you pled guilty or nolo contendere, or for which you were convicted or received probation before judgment?" and "Have you committed an offense involving alcohol or controlled substances to which

- you pled guilty or nolo contendere, or for which you were convicted or received probation before judgment?"
3. Despite her answers, the CJIS report received by the Board revealed that Ms. Queen did have a criminal background. The CJIS report showed that Ms. Queen received probation for judgment on numerous traffic violations and possession of a controlled dangerous substance following an arrest on August 16, 2012. The CJIS report also showed that Ms. Queen received one year of probation following an arrest for second-degree assault in 2004.
 4. On or about June 29, 2015, Ms. Queen provided the Board an explanation of her criminal background. She admitted both of her arrests and explained the circumstances involved in both incidents.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Ms. Queen is subject to discipline pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 12-6B-02(b)(1) and 12-6B-09(2) and (22).

ORDER

Based on an affirmative vote of the Board, it is this 16th day of November, 2015, hereby:

ORDERED that Ms. Queen be GRANTED a pharmacy technician registration; and be it further,

ORDERED that upon the first renewal of her pharmacy technician registration, Ms. Queen shall submit to a State criminal history records check; and be it further,

ORDERED that in the event Ms. Queen's criminal history records check indicates further criminal activity, the Board may impose further disciplinary action against Ms. Queen's registration, including suspension or revocation, after notice and an opportunity for a hearing; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Queen shall be responsible for all costs associated with this Consent Order; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions § 4-333(b).

CONSENT

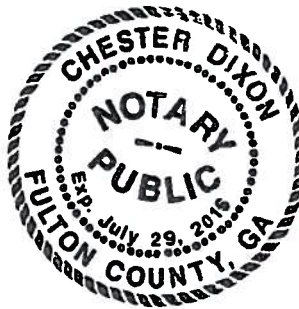
1. By signing this Consent, I hereby affirm the findings of fact contained herein and agree to be bound by the foregoing Consent Order and its conditions.
