

CONSENT ORDER

Background

On or about April 25, 2012, Timothy Schnupp submitted a pharmacy technician renewal application to the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), in accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-07(c). On his renewal application, Mr. Schnupp answered "yes" to the question "Excluding minor traffic violations, are you currently under arrest or released on bond, or are there any current or pending charges against you in any court of law?" Mr. Schnupp admitted to having been arrested and charged with driving while impaired by alcohol and driving while under the influence of alcohol on March 2, 2012.

In lieu of instituting formal proceedings against Mr. Schnupp's registration, in accordance with the Maryland Pharmacy Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-01 *et seq.*, the Board has offered Mr. Schnupp the opportunity to resolve this matter by agreeing to the terms set forth in this Consent Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Mr. Schnupp was initially registered as a pharmacy technician on May 9, 2008.
- 2. On or about April 25, 2012, Mr. Schnupp applied for renewal of his pharmacy technician registration.

- 3. On his renewal application, Mr. Schnupp answered "yes" to the question "Excluding minor traffic violations, are you currently under arrest or released on bond, or are there any current or pending charges against you in any court of law?"
- 4. Mr. Schnupp provided a detailed explanation regarding the circumstances surrounding the criminal charge.
- 5. Mr. Schnupp admitted that on March 2, 2012, he was charged with driving while impaired by alcohol and driving while under the influence of alcohol. Mr. Schnupp stated that he has not yet appeared in court on the charges, but that he is already enrolled in state-recognized alcohol classes.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Mr. Schnupp is subject to discipline pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-02(b)(1).

<u>ORDER</u>

Based on an affirmative vote of the Board, it is this $\frac{9\%}{100}$ day of $\frac{100}{100}$, 2012, hereby:

ORDERED that upon the next renewal of Mr. Schnupp's pharmacy technician registration in April 2014, he shall submit to a State criminal history records check; and be it further,

ORDERED that in the event Mr. Schnupp's criminal history records check indicates further criminal activity, the Board may impose further disciplinary action against Mr. Schnupp's registration, including suspension or revocation, after notice and an opportunity for a hearing; and be it further,

ORDERED that Mr. Schnupp shall be responsible for all costs associated with this Consent Order; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Md. Code Ann., State Gov't, § 10-617(h).
