ORDER OF MODIFICATION

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy is in receipt of a petition from Kelly Sobota, License No. 17170, requesting modification of the terms of probation as set forth in a Final Consent Order, dated September 6, 2006. The Consent Order provides that Ms. Sobota may petition for modification of the probationary terms after one (1) year of probation. Specifically, Ms. Sobota requests lifting the 32 hour per week limitation on her practice as a dispensing pharmacist, and terminating the prohibition against access to controlled dangerous substances. Upon consideration of Ms. Sobota's request, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

ORDER

It is this 15th day of Nov., 2007, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

ORDERED that Ms. Sobota may practice pharmacy as a dispensing pharmacist no more than 40 hours per week; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Sobota may have access to controlled dangerous substances; and be it further,

ORDERED that all of the other terms of the September 6, 2006, Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
