**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION AND
REINSTATING PHARMACY TECHNICIAN REGISTRATION**

On September 6, 2013, the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") issued an Order of Suspension of Registration for Delinquent Child Support ("Order of Suspension") against Christopher Williams, Pharmacy Technician, Registration No. T10608 (the "Respondent"). The Board suspended the Respondent's registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland due to his delinquent child support payments upon a request from the Prince George's County Office of the Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the "Administration"), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(e)(2)(i) (2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about September 24, 2013, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent's registration from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Pharmacy Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 12-101 *et seq.*, the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a registration.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(k), on this 15th day of October, 2013, by the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland held by Christopher Williams, Registration No. T10608, is **LIFTED**; and it is further,

ORDERED that the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in Maryland held by Christopher Williams, Registration No. T10608, is **REINSTATED** without restrictions or conditions; and it is further,

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't §§10-617(h).
