

DEA Alerts Pharmacies of Phishing Scam Asking Registrants for Sensitive Data

Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) is alerting pharmacies of a fax-based phishing scam that is asking for licensing information. A [sample](#) of the scam fax document requesting pharmacies to provide a copy of the current DEA certificate and state license is available in the [DEA alert](#), which also notes that DEA does not send unsolicited faxes or emails requesting sensitive data. DEA urges registrants who have already provided this information to contact their local field office.
