NOTICE

March 24, 2020

This notice is given by Robert R. Neall, Secretary of the Maryland Department of Health (the “Department”), acting pursuant to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. (the “Governor”) dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, as it may be amended or renewed from time to time, and the Order of the Governor dated March 12, 2020 entitled “Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements,” as it may be amended from time to time, after finding that the action described herein will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.

The Department will suspend the effect of COMAR 10.68.01.03.C.(2), which sets the deadline for submission of a community health worker certification application for exemption from the training program requirements under this section as March 31, 2020, until 30 days after the state of emergency is terminated and the catastrophic health emergency is rescinded. Any effect of Title 13, Subtitle 37 of the Health-General Article and the implementing regulations in COMAR 10.68 that inconsistent with the foregoing is hereby suspended.

This Notice is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until 30 days after the state of emergency has been terminated and the proclamation of the catastrophic health emergency has been rescinded.
