



Telehealth Treatment Options

There are many options available through individual healthcare providers for telehealth treatment. Listed below are alternative telehealth treatment options available statewide.

Baltimore Convention Center Field Hospital (BCCFH) COVID Task Force: Maryland operates an outpatient COVID-19 treatment program with a [self-referral telehealth treatment program](#) for people who are not able to see a provider in a timely way. BCCFH is able to guide eligible patients through telehealth, prescriptions, or a referral for COVID-19 treatment. Call 410-649-6122, the BCCFH Covid Task Force Call Center, with questions. Services are at no charge to the patient.

CVS Telehealth: Visit the CVS COVID-19 Resource Center page, if you are experiencing symptoms and are seeking a COVID-19 test or if you've already tested positive for COVID-19 and are interested in scheduling an appointment with a MinuteClinic provider who can assess their diagnosis and eligible patients will be able to receive a prescription for an oral antiviral at the [CVS COVID-19 resource center](#). Fees may apply.

MedStar eVisit: Medstar Health provides 24/7/365 access for acute conditions via telehealth visits. Patients with symptoms, positive home COVID tests, or other concerns can be evaluated remotely, and a provider will determine a plan for care, including therapeutic treatment options.
