

Maryland Monoclonal Antibody Treatment Administration Locations for COVID-19

This document lists referral sites for monoclonal antibody treatment administration for COVID-19. For more information about monoclonal antibodies and eligibility requirements, visit covidLINK and view FAQs. A provider must refer you to a site (unless otherwise indicated). Talk to your health care provider as soon as you test positive for COVID-19 or are aware that you have been exposed to COVID-19 so they can determine if monoclonal antibodies are the right treatment for you.

If you do not have a healthcare provider, contact <u>eVisit</u> to schedule a virtual appointment or complete a <u>self-referral form</u>. If it is determined you are eligible, you will be referred to an infusion site for treatment. If you do not have access to the internet, you may call 410-649-6122 (Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m) to receive information on monoclonal applicability over the phone.

The following sites offer monoclonal antibody treatment for COVID-19 cases, and certain sites offer post-exposure prophylaxis for high-risk individuals after a COVID-19 exposure. Your provider will determine your eligibility and, if appropriate, refer you to a site based on availability.

Locations and availability of treatment is subject to change. Hours of operation may vary.
