

HIV Overview: 2025



703 people aged 13+ were diagnosed with HIV in Maryland in 2025.



At year-end 2025, there were **32,586** people aged 13+ living with diagnosed HIV in Maryland.



90.1% of people living with diagnosed HIV in 2025 have been diagnosed. An estimated **3,580** people with HIV remain undiagnosed.



At year-end 2024, **1.1 million (1,158,701)** persons in the United States aged 13+ were living with diagnosed HIV.



Maryland was ranked **15th** among states and territories in adult/adolescent HIV diagnosis rates (per 100,000) in 2024.
