Notice of Opportunity for Public Inspection and Comment

In accordance with the Regulatory Review and Evaluation Act, [State Government Article, §§ 10-130—10-139](#), Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) is reviewing and evaluating certain regulations codified within Title 10 of the Code of Maryland Regulations. The purpose of the review and evaluation is to determine whether existing regulations continue to accomplish the purposes for which they were adopted, clarify ambiguous or unclear language, and repeal obsolete or duplicative provisions.
