## **CEHPAC IAQ & Schools Workgroup Report**

March 17, 2023

The IAQ and Schools Workgroup had two meetings since the last CEHPAC meeting. Our members continue to focus and dedicate our time to identifying the various ways that CEHPAC can be of service to the children of Maryland in the places where they spend the most time outside of home.

We have spent a lot of time reviewing the attached "Summary of Findings," provided as the Workgroup Status Report. This is in response to CEHPAC's ask of this Workgroup to review the December 1, 2022 Maryland Department of Agriculture's Joint Chairmen's Report on IPM in Schools Report, and provide our feedback. At our last meeting a vote was taken to send this spreadsheet along to CEHPAC members, which the majority agreed it was important to do. I will note that Kelly Love with the Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA) does not agree that this spreadsheet is a completely true account of what is happening in schools today. There is acknowledgement that there are areas for needed improvement. The challenge that the Workgroup had is that we can only go on what has been submitted through the over 500 pages of MDA IPM in Schools Report.

Moving forward, there are some suggested ways that the CEHPAC may decide to respond.

- A correspondence to the MD legislature with our review of the MDA JCR IPM in Schools Report requesting support in the full implementation of the 1997 School IPM Law (ie. budget, increased capacity needs for MDA, etc.)
- The IAQ & Schools Workgroup can continue to navigate through primary action needs
  with specific recommendations to the CEHPAC for further decisions on the best
  approach forward. Examples of needed actions that have come up through the
  Workgroup activities (including initial discussions with IPM School Coordinators)
  include:
  - Education of parents and school systems on the importance of the School IPM Law and need to support the School IPM Coordinators in their work to implement practices.
  - o Assisting MDA with updating the related content on their website.
  - Ensuring that school IPM plans that are indicated as "Plan TBD" in the MDA IPM
    in Schools report are actually followed up with to confirm that the plan was
    indeed established, with a current copy of that plan available.
  - o Considering ways to enhance school construction policies so that wood framing is not kept in a completed new structure. (This has been a problem with termites).
  - Encouraging all School Boards to make all IPM School Plans easily available to the public.
