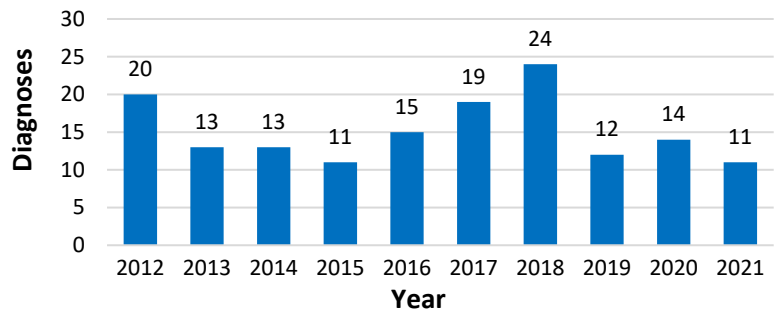

New HIV Diagnoses

In 2021, there were 11 people diagnosed with HIV in Frederick County.

- 45.5% of the 11 reported HIV diagnoses in Frederick County during 2021 were among NH-Black people.
- Of the 11 HIV diagnoses in 2021, 27.3% were among adults ages 30-39 years old, 27.3% were among those ages 60+, and 18.2% were among those ages 13-19.

At the end of 2021, there were 498 people living with diagnosed HIV in Frederick County.

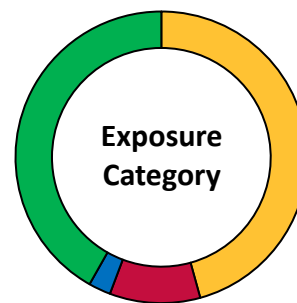

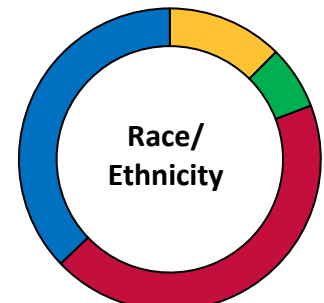

- Rates (per 100,000) were two times as high in males (279.2) as compared to females (148.3).
- Rates among people living with diagnosed HIV were 3 to 8 times higher among NH-Black people (885.3) as compared to Hispanic people (258.6) and NH-White people (110.6). 43.6% of people living with diagnosed HIV in Frederick County were NH-Black.
