


HIV IN GARRETT COUNTY, 2019

New HIV Diagnoses

In 2019, there were 0 new HIV diagnoses in Garrett County.

- Over the past 10 years, there have been a total of 6 new HIV diagnoses in Garrett County.
- Of the 6 HIV diagnoses in the past 10 years, 83.3% were among NH-Whites.
 Furthermore, 66.7% of the diagnoses were among adults ages 20-29 years old, and 16.7% were among those ages 30-39.



People Living with Diagnosed HIV

At the end of 2019, there were 17 people living with diagnosed HIV in Garrett County.



- Rates (per 100,000) were three times as high in males (104.3) compared to females (31.1).
- Of the 17 people currently living with diagnosed HIV in Garrett County, 12 (69.4%) had an estimated or reported exposure of MSM, followed by 17.6% for IDU exposure and 12.9% for HET exposure.
