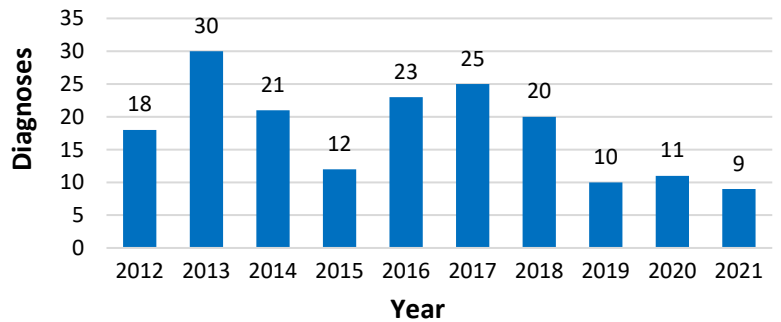

New HIV Diagnoses

In 2021, there were 9 people diagnosed with HIV in Harford County.

- 66.7% of the 9 reported HIV diagnoses in Harford County during 2021 were among NH-Black people and 33.3% among NH-White people.
- Of the 9 HIV diagnoses in 2021, 44.4% were among adults ages 20-29 years old, 44.4% were among those ages 30-39, and 11.1% were among those ages 40-49.

At the end of 2021, there were 537 people living with diagnosed HIV in Harford County.

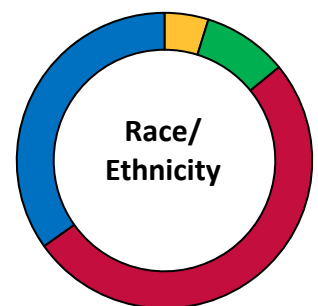
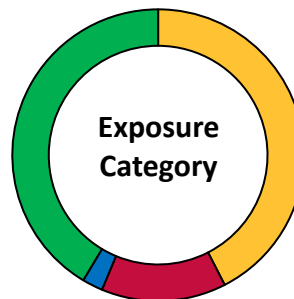

- Rates (per 100,000) were two times as high in males (330.9) as compared to females (156.9).
- Rates among people living with diagnosed HIV were 3 to 8 times higher among NH-Black people (860.7) as compared to Hispanic people (255.1) and NH-White people (111.5). 51.0% of people living with diagnosed HIV in Harford County were NH-Black.
