

New HIV Diagnoses

In 2021, there were 7 people diagnosed with HIV in Saint Mary's County.

- 71.4% of the 7 reported HIV diagnoses in Saint Mary's County during 2021 were among NH-Black people and 28.6% among NH-White people.
- Of the 7 HIV diagnoses in 2021, 57.1% were among adults ages 30-39 years old, and 28.6% were among those ages 40-59.

At the end of 2021, there were 169 people living with diagnosed HIV in Saint Mary's County.





- Rates (per 100,000) were two times as high in males (245.6) as compared to females (109.3).
- Rates among people living with diagnosed HIV were 11 to 20 times higher among NH-Black people (810.5) as compared to NH-White people (70.7) and Hispanic people (40.2). 66.3% of people living with diagnosed HIV in Saint Mary's County were NH-Black.
