

The Provider Report Card provides each organization with monthly statistics of the organization's reported data to ImmuNet, such as data completeness and timeliness. The purpose is to improve ImmuNet data quality by meeting the targets set forth by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Report access is based on ImmuNet user role and can be viewed/downloaded as a .pdf file and .csv file.

The Provider Report Card focuses on the sections below:

Recommendations - data fields where improvements are needed;

**Dose Timeliness** - delay between the date a vaccine was given and the date it was reported to ImmuNet;

**Data Completeness (Immunization)** - data elements for each vaccination reported (e.g. vaccine manufacturer name, vaccine lot numbers);

**Data Completeness (Patient)** - data elements for each patient reported (e.g. phone number, mother's middle name, etc.);

Invalid Doses - vaccination administered outside the recommended ACIP schedule;

**Unexpected Doses** - number of specific administered vaccination that may be valid but should otherwise not occur frequently;

**VFC** - number of vaccinations eligible for the Vaccines for Children program.
