HealthHIV: Black Women's Health across the Lifespan

Black adolescent and adult women in the U.S. are disproportionately affected by HIV, STIs, COVID-19, intimate partner violence, stigma, and poor maternal and child health outcomes. The impact of these inequities can accumulate across the lifespan, undermining their overall health outcomes. This three-part collaborative learning series will discuss pressing issues in the lives of Black adolescent and adult women as they age.

CDC: <u>STD QCS User Guide and Tools</u>

In January, CDC published Recommendations for Providing Quality Sexually Transmitted Diseases Clinical Services (or STD QCS). The goal of the recommendations is to highlight the services healthcare settings can offer to provide optimal STD care for their patients. This webinar will cover the STD QCS Planning Toolkit created by the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) which includes a user guide and assessment tools to help healthcare settings translate the recommendations into practical application.

International Antiviral Society-USA: <u>Management and</u> Prevention of HIV Infection among Transgender Adults

Transgender and gender diverse people have disparate rates of HIV infection compared with cisgender populations due to a combination of structural, individual, interpersonal, biologic, and network factors. This presentation will review recent epidemiologic data related to HIV in transgender populations and describe current and evolving strategies to improve HIV prevention and care, including the effects of genderaffirming care on ART and HIV outcomes.
