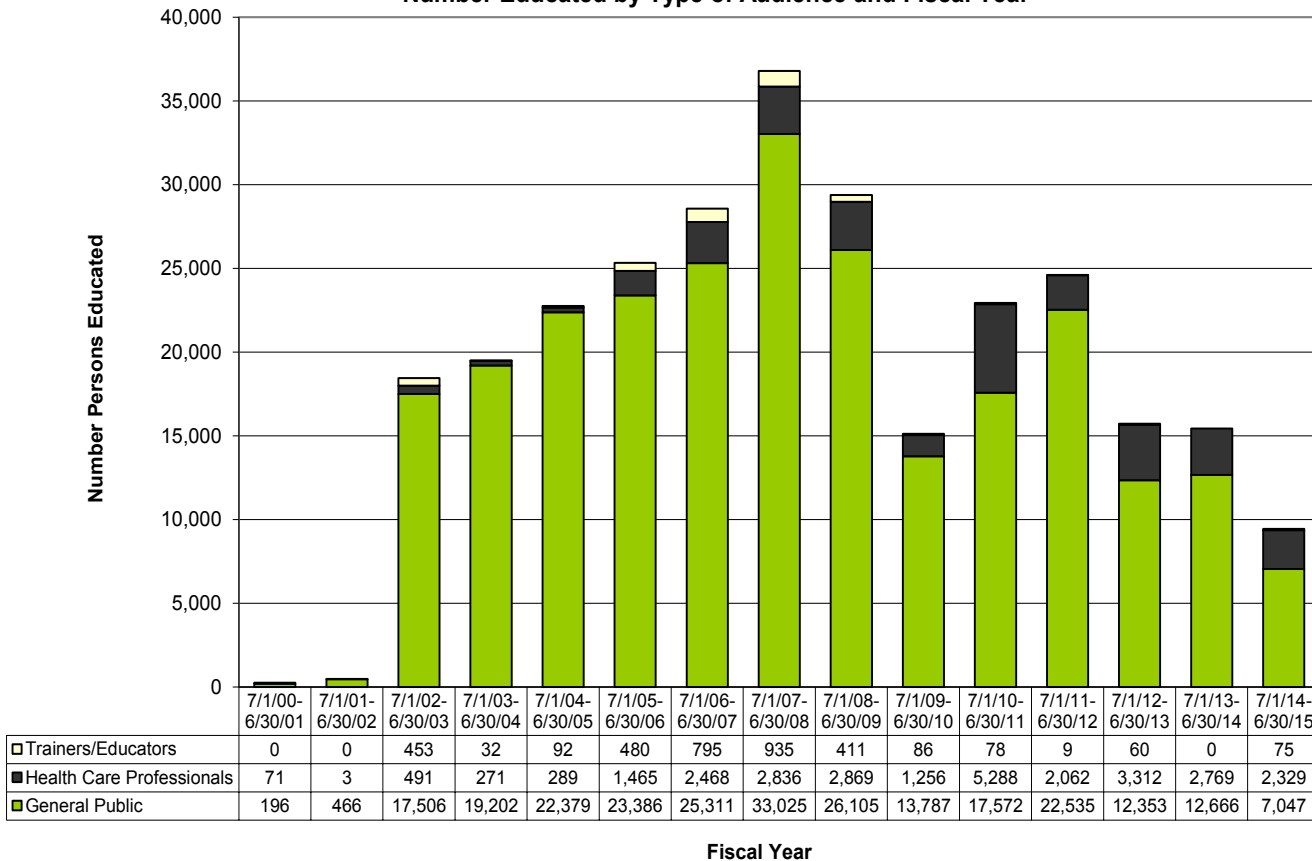
Overall Goals: Decrease cancer mortality; Reduce disparities among minorities

Education

Statewide Number Educated about Prostate Cancer—July 1, 2000 – June 30, 2015:

- **284,821** people educated in brief, group, or individual sessions including 253,536 general public, 27,779 health care professionals, and 3,506 trainers
- 6 out of 24 jurisdictions provided prostate cancer education in FY15
