

Advance Health Care Directive Wallet Card

Accessible printable version

An advance health care directive, which includes a living will, is only useful if it can be found and read when you are unable to make medical decisions for yourself. This card is meant to help your doctor or family quickly find your directive.

These cards are not the same as a do not resuscitate order. If you want emergency medical services personnel to refrain from resuscitating you, you need a Maryland Medical Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment form. That form must be completed by a physician or nurse practitioner.
