#### Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome

### What is Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome?

- Rare heart defect which is present at birth (congenital)
- Condition in which the left side of the heart is very underdeveloped or too small
- The left side of the heart can't effectively pump blood to the body, therefore the right side of the heart tries to pump blood both to the lungs *and* to the rest of the body

# What is the cause of Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome?

• It occurs during fetal growth and development but the cause is unknown

## Signs and Symptoms

- Grayish blue skin color, especially around lips and fingernails
- · Fast and difficult breathing
- Poor feeding
- Cold hands and feet
- Lethargy (tiredness)

## How is Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome treated?

- Medication can be used to improve blood flow, but surgical treatment or heart transplant is needed
- Surgical treatment involves a three step surgical procedure to create normal blood flow in and out of the heart which will allow the body to receive the oxygen-rich blood
