<p>Pregnancy</p> <p>NHV does not initiate a decreased visit schedule. Decrease only if client requests reduction.</p>	<p>Telehealth added PRN to provide additional support to clients with higher risks although does not replace in person visit unless this is the client's desire or to avoid no contact with client at all.</p>	<p>MAINTAIN normal visit schedule.</p>	<p>Consider INCREASING visits: If client in yellow zone in: Personal Health categories Maternal Role categories #12 Loneliness and Isolation #13 IPV #14 Unsafe Family and Friends #19 Health Services Utilization</p>	<p>Consider INCREASING visits: If client in red zone in: Personal Health categories Maternal Role categories #12 Loneliness and Isolation #13 IPV #14 Unsafe Family and Friends #19 Health Services Utilization</p>
<p>Infancy</p> <p>Moms should be seen in person at least once during the first 4 weeks post-partum and at least twice during the first 8 weeks post-partum.</p> <p>After 12 weeks postpartum offer visit schedule and method based on client risk and need.</p>	<p>Telehealth may be added PRN for additional support to clients with higher risks and may also be to avoid missed scheduled face to face visits such as a last-minute cancellation.</p> <p>From 3-12 months, telehealth may be offered on a planned schedule determined by the client and nurse with supervisor input to meet client needs based on client current risk.</p>	<p>DECREASE visit schedule at 12 weeks post-partum:</p> <p>If client in green zone in: Personal Health categories Maternal Role categories #13 IPV #14 Unsafe Family and Friends #16 Homelessness and Residential Instability</p> <p>To accommodate client need such as work/school schedule if client requests reduction or based on client current risk schedule.</p>	<p>MAINTAIN visit schedule: If client in yellow zone in: Personal Health categories Maternal Role categories #12 Loneliness and Isolation #13 IPV #14 Unsafe Family and Friends #19 Health Services Utilization</p> <p>May INCREASE visits PRN.</p> <p>May DECREASE visit schedule to accommodate client need or if client requests reduction.</p>	<p>Consider INCREASING visit schedule: If client in red zone in: Personal Health categories Maternal Role categories #8 Maternal Education and Work #12 Loneliness and Social Isolation #13 IPV #14 Unsafe Family and Friends #18 Home Safety #20 Well Child Care</p> <p>May DECREASE visit schedule to accommodate client need or if client requests reduction.</p>
